Engage your students in current events and community service. The Cool School Challenge integrates climate change with social research and action.

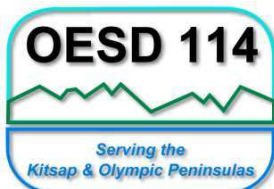
- ◆ Students will learn how they can lessen their environmental impact; reduce their individual "carbon footprint" and get their school involved in the same process.

The **Cool School Challenge** engages students, teachers and school districts in a school-wide initiative **to reduce carbon dioxide (CO₂) emissions** by 2,000 pounds or more per classroom, per school year. The **Challenge** empowers students to become leaders, take action, and make a difference. The program can be administered by any teacher interested in becoming a "**Challenge Coach**," and is especially suited for **science and social studies teachers**.

We invite you to learn more about the program and how you can become a "**Challenge Coach**." At the workshop you will **receive all the materials to implement the Cool Schools Challenge, and as an added bonus, "Facing the Future" activity guide**. Clock hours will be available. Additionally, teachers in Puget Sound Energy's service territory, Kitsap and parts of Jefferson County, who attend and then get their students to participate in the **Challenge** will receive a **\$300.00 stipend** after they have submitted their results and a program evaluation.
